Members,

This has been an exciting year for *your* club. In fact I may not have enough room to include the many achievements that, w/your support, we've been able to accomplish! So take a moment and read though what we've done to improve our sport for others to enjoy. By building on the partnerships we started in 2013, we expect 2014 to be even better! I ask for your continued support in 2014 and please invite a friend or business to join us. We depend on our membership dollars to support our projects in developing, constructing and maintaining our trail systems. I have listed a few of our 2013 accomplishments for you to show to your friends.

2013 MI-TRALE Accomplishments

1-Completed new 70mi East Connector by partnering w/ONF&MDNR & over 150 signs installed in 1day w/our partners! 2-Completed bridge in Paulding over Bluff Creek. Another step in the connector from Bruce Crossing to Watersmeet. Done by partnering w/Ontonagon Cty Road Commission & w/support of MI-TRALE volunteers. 3-Completed remediation of Pioneer multi-use trail from Norwich Road to FR400-6.2 milesusing grant approved by the MDNR. 4-Completed remediation of about 200vds of trail on Courtney Equestrian System w/funds from NFS. 5-Updated signage on our club supported trails to improve rider safety & sign quality-about 600 signs. 6-Partnered w/5 counties to develop a 1st Responder Signage System. Signs were installed in Ontonagon Cty w/support of the local emergency mgr. Remaining counties will take place next spring. 7-Worked w/partner ONF developing Pori & Healthy Forest projects. 8-Working w/ONF on a joint 2014 ORV use map. 9-ROW signage done on 4 major connectors in MI-TRALEs trail system. Partnered w/MDNR & MDOT to make this a reality. Other org's in the UP helped to obtain a total of 12 ROW connectors being approved & implemented in the UP. 10-E entrance to Bergland installed-lengthened to the W from orig design. Also supported by MDNR & GAG. 11-Helped to develop the Ontonagon Cty Recreat'l Advisory Work Group made up of Ontonagon Cty, Twnship & Village appointed rep's. This partnership resulted in approval to develop & sign an ORV/Snowmobile Loop in the village of Ontonagon & create a new trail head w/in the village for both ORV & snowmobilers. 12-Worked w/GAG to officially reg replacement of bridge over W Branch of the Ontonagon River E of Bergland. This route is shared by ORVs & snowmobiles. 13-Worked w/other org's in MI on key legislative bills in Lansing. 14-Organized an informational session w/Pure Michigan. A follow-up session to be scheduled for JAN. This is part of MI-TRALEs effort to bring riders into the Western UP. 15-Held 2ndAnnual S.P.O.R.T. Ride w/MDNR. 16-Held 6thAnnual Senior Citizen Fall Color Ride. 17-Developing a meeting w/MDNR for January-2014 to see if there is any interest to have a UP Trails Week as a subset of the Michigan Trails Week in SEPT-2014. Initial contacts look very good. 18-MI-TRALE supported 2 local 4th of July parades this year: White Pine & Bruce Crossing. 19-Gave presentations to various org's on the economic benefits of the ORV recreational trail system to local economies and how we need to work together to change from just trail riding to destination family riding. We need to stress POIs, history, waterfalls, wildlife, day trips & day planning. **Overview View of MI-TRALE**
